# MONTHLY

#### Inside

- □ Clean out refrigerator
- Clean toilets
- □ Clean/dust ceiling fans
- Clean/dust HVAC vents and return

# QUARTERLY

#### Inside

- Change air filter
- Clean dishwasher
- Clean sinks/drains
- Clean showers/tub drains
- Set up pest control for your home

# BI-ANNUALLY

## Inside

Nddro

- Service HVAC (beginning of Spring and end of Fall)
- Change the refrigerator water filter
- Clean stove, oven, vent hood, and vent hood filters

## Outside

- $\hfill\square$  Mow lawn as appropriate
- □ Clean door handles
- Wash out trash cans
- For pools and hot tubs, maintain as appropriate

## Outside

- Fertilize grass
- Change flower beds each season
- Add mulch to yard (as needed in the Spring)
- Check roof shingles and chimney for storm damage

## ANNUALLY

## Inside

- Check hot water heater
- Clean garbage disposal
- Clean fireplace:
  - For wood burning, have chimney swept based on use
  - For gas burning, have fireplace inspected/ serviced based on use
- Check outlets for cracked face plates and blackened plugs
- Replace smoke detector batteries
- Check windows for correct operation, cracks and leaks

## Outside

- Trim foliage
- Spread weed preemergent
- Clean dryer vent at the dryer connection and the outside outlet
- Check roof flashing for cracking
- Check all siding for cracking or chipping paint
- Check brick & mortar for cracking or crumbling
- Check composite siding for cracking or gaping caulk
- Check wood siding for soft spots and rotting
- Check outside doors to ensure no leaking air and good weather stripping
- □ Check garage door

# EVERY 2-5 YEARS

## Every 2 Years

- Prune trees
- Familiarize yourself with your circuit panel
- 🗖 Clean carpet

## Every 5 Years

- Clean out P traps under sinks
- Power wash and re-stain your fence
- Power wash house
